Chair David Hartwell discussed the letter that the Council received regarding unauthorized use of Neonicotinoid products on LSOHC funded lands, and how to ensure that verification is done on the use of Neonicotinoid products going forward. Chair Hartwell and members discussed factors relating to this question including past success of these organizations and considering if the work funded by the Council is being accomplished and if it is finished as scheduled.
