7. Council Discussion: <u>(08:14:36)</u>

Chair Hartwell provided an opportunity for members of the Council to discuss their thoughts on the proposal hearings and additional issues that had been examined during the meetings. Councilmember Holsten requested that Council staff provide data on amounts of open appropriations from past projects as well as the amount of leverage received by partner organizations. Council members discussed the positives and negatives of encouraging public access on OHF funded lands. The Council examined the potential for members to recommend changes to the permitting process to legislators. Members discussed opinions on specific project proposals. Chair Hartwell informed the Council that the upcoming state budget forecast may affect the overall budget available for project appropriations and provided general guidelines for making appropriation recommendations.
