

- 1.5 "Sec. 3. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 97A.056, subdivision 12, is amended to read:
- 1.6 Subd. 12. **Accomplishment plans.** (a) It is a condition of acceptance of money
- 1.7 appropriated from the outdoor heritage fund that the agency or entity using the appropriation
- 1.8 submits an accomplishment plan and periodic accomplishment reports to the Lessard-Sams
- 1.9 Outdoor Heritage Council in the form determined by the council. The accomplishment plan
- 1.10 must identify the project manager responsible for expending the appropriation and the final
- 1.11 product. The accomplishment plan must account for the use of the appropriation and
- 1.12 outcomes of the expenditure in measures of wetlands, prairies, forests, and fish, game, and
- 1.13 wildlife habitat restored, protected, and enhanced. The plan must include an evaluation of
- 1.14 results. If lands are acquired by fee with money from the outdoor heritage fund, the
- 1.15 accomplishment plan must include a hunting and fishing management plan for the lands
- 1.16 acquired by fee. No money appropriated from the outdoor heritage fund may be expended
- 1.17 unless the council has approved the pertinent accomplishment plan.
- 1.18 (b) If an appropriation from the outdoor heritage fund will result in or contribute to
- 1.19 restoration or enhancement habitat work on land, it is a condition of acceptance of the money
- 1.20 that the recipient include the following in the accomplishment plan:
- 1.21 (1) an agreement that the recipient of the appropriation will notify all adjacent property
- 1.22 owners by certified mail of the work to be performed. The notice must include the name,
- 1.23 phone number, and email of the project manager or local contact so that adjacent property
- 1.24 owners can contact the person with questions about the project. A copy of the notification
- 1.25 letter must be attached to the accomplishment plan; and
- 1.26 (2) an explanation of how the recipient will seek approval from adjacent property owners if
- 1.27 access to adjacent land is required to perform the work.
- 1.28 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective July 1, 2025, and applies to appropriations
- 1.29 from the outdoor heritage fund on or after that date."
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
